Thank you for expressing an interest in serving as a Game Leader in this year's National Academic Mathematics Pentathlon Tournament. Serving as a Game Leader is a rewarding experience in many ways. One is financial! If approved as a Game Leader you may designate one child to participate in the Mathematics Pentathlon[®] Tournament at no cost. To offer this benefit, it is important that you fulfill **ALL** responsibilities of the Game Leader position.

The Responsibilities for Game Leaders Include:

- Knowing the basic and tournament rules for ONE game very well and responding to questions about that game from supervisors on the day of the tournament.
- Participation as a Game Monitor in a least one prior tournament (except Division 1)
- Attendance at a recent Volunteer Orientation Session
- Contacting Game Monitors prior to competition to insure they know the game, as well as the date, time and place of the tournament. It may be necessary for Game Leaders to contact coaches to secure additional volunteers. All Game Monitor information will be provided by the Pentathlon Institute office.
- Participation in the Essential Game Leader Meeting and tournament preparation on the Friday before the tournament. *After game set-up is complete, all Game Leaders participate in an essential meeting with the Tournament Director to review important tournament procedures and arrangements.*
- Arriving at the tournament site the day of tournament at 7:15am to meet with co-leaders and supervisors volunteering in your game area.
- Assisting with the Award Ceremony.
