The team with the highest score in the nation receives the national team trophy. As with individual entries, team participants receive awards and recognition based on their individual performance. It is our long-standing tradition that each **Pentathlete™** is awarded for competing in all five events!

- 1 Registration** is limited and is arranged on a **first-come first-serve basis**. Each year increasing numbers of Pentathletes register to test their strategic thinking skills. **Register EARLY and SAVE! Register ONLINE and SAVE www.mathpentath.org**
- 2 Registration fee is \$39** online and **\$42** mailed-in until the posted registration deadline date. Fee **MUST** be received with registration form. Make check payable to Pentathlon Institute or use VISA or Mastercard to register. **REGISTRATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.**
- Registration forms will be processed on a first come first served basis until the posted registration deadline for each tournament. **Late registrations**, forms postmarked after **February 22, 2011** will be processed at **\$53** on a space available basis. **Registration fee during the week of the tournament is \$69 and based on available space.**
- In addition to division directors and gameleaders, **one adult supervisor is required for each two registered Pentathletes.** It is necessary that game monitors attend a Volunteer Official Session (VOS).
- Tournament registration forms may be duplicated. **Copy all information on both sides of this form. Registration Forms can be sent via Fax to (317) 356-6680 with Visa, Master Card or American Express payment information.**
