## Register ONLINE and SAVE! ~ 2010 National Mathematics Pentathlon® Tournament

- 1 Registration** is limited and is arranged on a **first-come first-serve basis**. Each year increasing numbers of Pentathletes register to test their strategic thinking skills. **Register EARLY and SAVE! Register ONLINE and SAVE MORE [www.mathpentath.org](http://www.mathpentath.org)**
- 2 Registration fee is \$35** online and **\$37** mailed-in until the posted registration deadline date. Fee **MUST** be received with registration form. Make check payable to Pentathlon Institute or use VISA or Mastercard to register. **REGISTRATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.**
- Registration forms will be processed starting May 15, 2009 until the posted registration deadline for each tournament. **Late registrations**, forms postmarked after **March 1, 2010** will be processed at **\$52** on a space available basis. **Registration fee during the week of the tournament is \$69 and based on available space.**
- In addition to division directors and gameleaders, **one adult supervisor is required for each two registered Pentathletes**. It is necessary that supervisors attend a Volunteer Official Session (VOS).
