Thank you for expressing an interest in serving as a Game Leader in this year's National Mathematics Pentathlon® Academic Tournament. Serving as a Game Leader is a rewarding experience in many ways. If approved as a Game Leader you may designate one child to participate in the Mathematics Pentathlon® Academic Tournament at no cost. To offer this benefit, it is important that you fulfill ALL responsibilities of the Game Leader position.

The Responsibilities for Game Leaders Include:

- Knowing the basic and tournament rules for ONE game very well and responding to questions about that game from Game Monitors on the day of the tournament.
- Participation as a Game Monitor in at least one prior tournament (except Division 1)
- Attendance at a recent Volunteer Orientation Session
- Contacting Game Monitors prior to competition to ensure they know the game, as well as the date, time and place of the tournament. All Game Monitor information will be provided by the Pentathlon Institute.
- Participation in the **Essential** Game Leader Meeting and tournament preparation on the **Friday before the tournament**. After game set-up is complete, all Game Leaders participate in an **essential** meeting with the Tournament Director to review important tournament procedures and arrangements.
- Arriving at the tournament site the day of tournament at 7:15am to meet with Co-Game Leaders and Game Monitors in your game area.
- Assisting with the Awards Ceremony.
