

Mathematics Pentathlon[®]

NATIONAL TEAM

INFORMATION & CRITERIA

The following criteria **MUST** be met in order for a school/club to enter as an Official National Mathematics Pentathlon[®] Tournament Team:

1. There must be a total of **EXACTLY 30 STUDENTS**.
2. These students must involve **EXACTLY 5 GRADE LEVELS**.
3. There must be equal gender representation of exactly **3 GIRLS & 3 BOYS FROM EACH GRADE LEVEL**.
4. Suggested Option: Each of the 5 grade levels is allowed 2 alternates (a boy and a girl) in case one of the listed Pentathletes[™] is unable to attend the day of tournament. (The team alternate slots are indicated on the Team Form).
5. **TEAM FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED.** (Team form on next page)
6. The school/club must meet the required Game Monitor Tournament Quota.

This permits a school to send up to 40 students as Team Members.

To register as a TEAM, all applicable registration fees and completed forms must be sent to the Pentathlon Institute by March 1 of the tournament year.

- If parents register their own child(ren) online, complete Team Form and mail.
- If coach used Coach's Registration Spreadsheet complete Team Form and mail.
- If Coaches collect registration forms and school is paying the registration fees, complete Accounting Form, Team Form, sort registrations by grade then last name, and mail with check.
- If Coaches collect registration forms and fees, complete Accounting Form, Team Form, sort registrations by grade then by last name, arrange checks in a similar manner (**DO NOT STAPLE CHECKS TO REGISTRATIONS**), rubber band checks, and mail.

IMPORTANT: Schools who send a team plus other individual Pentathletes do not inform students as to who is on the team. This allows all students from the school to feel that they are part of the national team. **NOTE:** The Pentathlon Institute does not publicize which students are team members. **ALL Pentathletes, whether members of a team or individual participants, are recognized for their individual efforts at the Mathematics Pentathlon Awards Ceremony.** Each team participating in a National Tournament Center is awarded either a First, Second, or Third Place Team Trophy or a large Honorable Mention Ribbon. A special National Team Trophy is awarded to the team scoring the highest points of all National Tournament Centers. Team awards will be given to winning schools 2 weeks after all results have been tabulated nationwide.
